Ambulance Case Raised Up by A Miracle



1, Mrs. Lioyd Humpnrey, 1933 Wank Avenue, St. Joseph, Missouri, do hereby declare the following testimony to be accurate and truthful.

I have suffered with heart trouble, and being a nurse I tried to obtain the best medical help possible. My heart was enlarged to the point where it resembled a long-necked gourd, reaching from the ribs on the left to beyond the midline on the right and pressing the diaphram. Instead of the regular rhythm of the normal heart, I had "gallop rhythm," or irregular beating, so that I was in pain most of the time. The pain extended down the left arm, through the chest and up the left side of my neck. My breathing was very laborious and I also had "Cardiac Asthma," with the lung tissues filling with fluid which had to be coughed up. This condition made breathing almost impossible. Hypodermics to dehydrate the fluid were given and I was placed under an oxygen tent as soon as an attack was over. Along with the heart condition came the complication of Bright's Disease which produces decompensation or dropsy, and I had only a 35% kidney function. The kidneys are a filter of the body and when they fail to function, poisons are retained in the body. As a result of this last, a severe case of arthritis was brought on and I was bedfast from Aug. 3, 1950 until March 1951, being unable to walk as the arthritis struck from the pelvis downward.

I had been given up by the physicians and told I was beyond medical help and could only live a short time. But then the miracle happened! Sister Louise Nankivell came to our city to hold a revival meeting I was taken in an ambulance to

The gift of discernment was prominent throughout the meetings as she described their diseases, their condition and character, often many things that would be a hindrance to their healing. These people were total strangers to her and things about them were only made known to her by these revelations of the Lord. They were called out of the audience, prayed for and healed, on the spot, coming back to give public testimony of remarkable healings.

Prophecy was manifested several times in the meeting as she yielded to the workings of the Holy Ghost. One night there was no preaching only prophecy which was filled with the Word of God and there was a tremendous response at the altar call for souls seeking Salvation. Sinners came nightly in response to the Salvation invitation until hundreds came forward throughout the meeting.

Raymond T. Richey Joins TVH As International Editor

Beginning with the next issue of THE VOICE OF HEALING, we will bring you a series of articles on the ministry of Raymond T. Richey, founder and co-pastor (with his brother Andrew J. Richey) of the Evangelistic Temple, in Houston, Texas. Plans have been made to include Brother Richey on our staff as international editor, thus giving THE VOICE OF HEALING the benefit of his wide range of contacts with the religious world.

Raymond Richey has been for many years one of America's best known evangelists and advocates of Divine Healing. Healed, while still a very young man, of almost total blindness, which specialists declared would become total in a matter of weeks, he began preaching the Gospel at once. Later healed of tuberculosis, after promising God he would use the health and strength given him to tell the story of the Christ who is "the same yesterday and today and forever;" he has been doing just as he promised. Over a million souls have answered the altar calls, and thousands have been prayed for for the healing of their bodies in the great campaigns across the country.

During World Wars I and II, he devoted much of his time working among the men in the service of our nation, first as a Civilian Chaplain, later as "Camp Pastor" in the first war. During World War II, the great "red, white and blue tent" went from Florida to Seattle, Washington and back, always near Training Centers. Now that our country is in a so-called "Cold War," he is as vitally interested in the spiritual well-being of our Service men and women

His time is divided between the Evangelistic Temple, a church which reaches far beyond the confines of Houston, with ministers and missionaries in many places in the United States and on foreign fields, who began their ministry and went out from the Evangelistic Temple, and the Richey Evangelistic Association, with headquarters at the Temple.

The Association is the outgrowth of the United Prayer and Workers League, organized during World War I, with Raymond Richey as president, and Mrs. Andrew J. Richey as secretary. retary, and Earl A. Richey, field secretary. Mrs. Andrew J. Richev was raised from a bed of affliction when the doctors had given her up, stating "Here's a chance to try your faith." God did heal her and after these many years her testimony still stands.

The work of the Association is nationwide and reaches into many countries outside our own-a work of prayer, of literature distribution, of radio broadcasts and of special ministry to Armed Service personnel, particularly in Hospitals and train-

I believe this woman has the gift of Faith, in the face of impossible cases. She possesses a faith that will not be denied. In one case, a man who had received a spinal injury in a car wreck, paralyzing him from the waist down, so that it was difficult for him to get around even with crutches, attended the meeting. Sister Nankivell prayed for him and told him to put away his crutches. He crumpled to the floor, but she insistently commanded him to rise and walk, and he straightened up as by a miracle, to the amazement of the people.

Some cases, given up by doctors with even organs of the body missing, and were so far gone that funeral arrangements had been made, were raised up before the eyes of the people, by a miracle of God.

These meetings were permeated with an unusual depth of spirituality accompanied with weeping, shouting, rejoicing, crying for joy. Eternity alone will reveal the great harvest that has been reaped during this great campaign. Fold in this city and people from miles around will never forget this wonderful visitation and our sister's ministry of love.

the auditorium and my breathing was so labored that I had to be fanned and have water to somewhat revive me. This was on March 18th, and Sister Nankivell prayed for me and within a few minutes the labored breathing stopped. She told me to "Put your hand in the hands of the Saviour and if He tells you to walk, get up and walk." I waited a few minutes, then it seemed that He said, "Rise and walk." Several ushers had to help me at first and before I hardly realized it I was walking alone. When I went into the building I had the gray pallor of death and my eyes were sunken. Several of my former patients were there with me and they said that a glow of radiance came over my face, the pallor left and a rosy hue took its place. I was overjoyed and so thankful to God for healing me.

I want to say in closing that I was hospitalized four times in 1950 and I cannot recall exactly how many times in 1949. The hospital records, my heart tracings and chest X-rays will substantiate my testimony. I am walking everywhere now, have had no more trouble with the former conditions and have been checked by my doctor and he said "It is wonderful indeed."

One night in Los Angeles, while I was preaching, I noticed "Sister Barbara" in the congregation. I had known her for about five years as we attended the same Bible College. However, during our College days, Barbara was Mrs. Burcaw, and I remember the many times she requested prayer for God to save her husband. About a year after Barbara graduated from Bible College, one day she received news of her husband's death at Chatsworth, California. He was one of the five railroad men who were killed when a large freight became stalled in the mile-long tunnel. This tragedy occurred when the coupling broke between two cars and the train was stalled in the small tunnel. The heat of the engine ignited the oil tankers directly behind the engine and there was a terrific explosion. The train burned for hours and five hundred head of cattle were burned alive. Barbara's husband, Mr. Burcaw, was smothered to death by monoxide poison. A number of Bible college students and I attended the funeral. The night she attended our revival was three years after her husband's death. We had a good visit that night after the preaching and reminisced our college days. After several such visits we considered marriage, and prayed over the matter for the next six months. After being convinced that we were in the will of God, we went to Idaho and were married. The Lord has highly favored our ministry together as we have traveled America, Canada and Newfoundland in Holy Ghost revivals. She is an ordained minister and has preached to thousands in city-wide revivals. She is deeply consecrated to the Gospel of Christ and has proved to be a great blessing in my life.

Barbara Seriously Injured

On our return from Canadian revivals she was severely injured as our car rolled over four times, end over end. The station wagon was reduced to kindling, landed on top of Barbara's back, breaking nine ribs and three places in her spine. Many doctors pronounced her case as hopeless and said that it would be a miracle for her to live. After God wonderfully spared her from almost certain death, doctors then said there was no hope of her ever walking

again but we know that God will heal her, even as he miraculously spared her life when physicians said she was dying.

Jesus Visits During Fasting and Prayer

Soon I was given a wonderful revelation by the Holy Spirit that God would raise up a people for His Name, and the Lord showed me that if I would be led by His Spirit He would reveal the Hidden Manna of the Word. Heavenly visitations became nightly experiences until I anticipated His visits. I do not affirm that God deals this special way with all of His people, neither do I believe that everyone receives the Word in such a strange manner from God. However, much of my ministry today is a reflection of these many visitations from the Lord. I HAVE BEEN PRIVILEGED TO SEE JESUS MORE THAN A DOZEN TIMES! Every time He looks at me it seems that His eyes penetrate every fibre of my being. Twice He walked into my room and stood at the foot of my bed. He always looks the same, merciful, lovable and kind. His Words are always "True and Faithful" and He always keeps His promise.

One night the Lord spoke to me and said "WITHIN THREE WEEKS I WILL GIVE YOU A NEW MINISTRY." I did not know exactly what He was referring to, but before the three weeks had expired I received a special gift of Scriptures in preaching of God's Word. Sometimes in a single night of preaching I have quoted seventyfive, eighty-five and even one hundred scriptures in my sermon, without opening the Bible. The Gift works like a Divine Concordance and without preparation or premeditation of any kind, when the Gift operates I am able to quote literally hundreds of Scriptures. I remember after MY CALL, I studied the Scriptures on a Scripture calendar for one week, and at the end of that time I COULD NOT REMEMBER THE VERSES LEARNED DURING THE FIRST DAYS. I never realized I could become a spokesman for God in regards to His holy Word. I do not know of a more joyous time than when I am heavily annointed in the quoting of His Word. The Scriptures come as fast as I can preach them.

During a certain fast the Lord spoke to me definitely about the great Revival which will SHAKE THE WORLD FOR GOD. About the thirty-fifth day of the fast He spoke in a very clear voice and related the experience of Elijah and Elisha. He told me that as Elisha received a double portion of the Spirit, so in like manner He would give a double portion to me and to many others. This will be given to those willing to give themselves in complete consecration and obedience.

The Lord has been faithful to His Promise and since that period of fasting and prayer we have witnessed wonderful healings of all kinds. Blind eyes have been opened, deaf ears unstopped, braces have come off withered limbs, and cancers and tumors have dried up.

There are not adequate words found to express the greatness of our God and the power of Jesus Christ His Son. He is moving again and again in His great power of Bible deliverance to deliver the captives and let the oppressed go free. We are now on the crest of one of the greatest healing ministries that this modern age has ever seen, and the next ministry which will become prominent will be the Ministry of Miracles and Exploits. As God's Elijahs fearlessly tread the courts of the enemy, Holy Ghost-anointed servants of God will stir the world and put the nations in the fear and remembrance of a mighty God who is able to save and deliver.

This age shall climax with the greatest deliverance that the Church has ever known.



THE CASE OF CARNAL COMPARISONS

by J. Ern Baxter

2 Cor. 10:12—"For we dare not make ourselves of the number, or compare ourselves with some that commend themselves: but they measure themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves among themselves, are not wise."

I Cor. 3:4—"For while one saith, I am of Paul; and another of Apollos; are ye not carnal?"

We thank god for such visitations of His power and blessing as are being experienced throughout the world at the present time. Entire cities are being stirred by great revival efforts which overflow the largest auditoriums, and in some instances, require the erection of special buildings to contain the crowds. The Gospel is the world's only hope, and we pray that these great Gospel efforts will continue to enlarge in power and influence until the whole world feels the influence of the Spirit of God.

Such moves as we refer to are, in most cases, spearheaded by certain men, obviously God-blessed and God-ordained for the task. It is our duty to pray for such men that they will be sustained in spirit, soul, and body, that they might be at their best constantly in this greatest of all bat-

There is, however, a great danger in such mighty movements where individuals are catapulted into places of prominence as leaders. Instead of humbly recognizing the hand of God in the whole, and the grace of God in equipping men for leadership, and thus giving all the glory to God, there is a tendency to humanly evaluate leaders, and compare and pick and choose favorites. Such an attitude indicates a limited vision. This robs God of His glory, is unfair to the leader, and contributes to the party spirit among Christians, which God so evidently deplores, as indicated in His word.

Each of these leaders, indeed every minister in the Church of God, has some distinctive features which makes him to differ from every other minister, and unless the great principle of ministerial oneness is recognized, there exists the constant danger of dividing God's people into as many groups as there are ministers to give them leadership.

"There is no new thing under the sun," and this seems especially true when considered in terms of error and defection among Christians. We can think of no modern system of error or trend of defection in the realm of professed Christian religion that had not appeared at least in germ form in the days of the apostles, and which was not given apostolic treatment in the

sacred writings of the New Testament. The subject with which we are dealing received extensive attention from the Apostle Paul in the Corinthian epistles, as well as being referred to in other epistles. Although the directions given in the Corinthian epistles are intended primarily to meet the local conditions, they, nevertheless, are applicable on a body-wide scale.

The apostle declares the condition that exists in the Corinthian church by saying, "It hath been declared unto me of you, my brethren, by them which are of the house of Chloe, that there are contentions among you. Now this I say, that every one of you saith, I am of Paul; and I of Apollos; and I of Cephas; and I of Christ." (I Cor. 1:11, 12). There certainly had been a good deal of carnal comparison indulged here. Paul mentions himself first, for a group in the Corinthian church had chosen him as their preferred preacher, quite evidently without any encouragement from him. Paul indicates his sincerity in deploring and attempting to correct this party spirit by placing his name first on the list, and thus being the first to be demoted as a sectarian leader. No doubt, the Gentile believers clung to Paul as their leader, as against those Jews which preferred Peter with his background.

Then there were those who were followers of Apollos, described in the Scripture as "an eloquent man, and mighty in the Scriptures" (Acts 18:24). Apollos was an Alexandrian Jew, distinguished for literary culture and eloquence, and it is probable that the more highly educated among the Corinthian Christians were his peculiar followers.

Then there were the Cephasites, the followers of Cephas, or Peter. He, of course, had an apparent priority over the others, being one of the first followers of Jesus. His apostleship was well established, there being no argument as in the case of Paul. He was a "senior minister," and there were those who felt that he deserved a superior place, and so were quite prepared to battle for his leadership.

Finally, Paul mentions the Christ party. This may at first seem strange, for we should all be "of Christ." It has been suggested, however, that "this sect of Christ probably rejected the apostles, and professed to be admirers and followers of the traditional sayings of Jesus. They approved His ethics, but rejected the doctrines outlined in the Gospel, and more fully expounded in the epistles. Possibly, the apostle had this group in mind when he wrote, "Henceforth know we no man after the flesh: yea, though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we Him no more." (II Cor. 5:16)

The apostle counters this condition with three pertinent questions, the first one being, "Is Christ divided?" Of course, the answer to this is an emphatic "No!" The body of Christ is one, and knows but one head, the risen and glorified Lord Jesus Christ. The one head governs the body, instructing the various members concerning their duty, and appointing the various tasks for the individual parts of the body. Thus, instead of individual members of the body setting up an independent centre of government and control, they must at all times adhere to the authority of the head. The structure of the human body contains the equipment for controlling and directing the various functions of the body. It has the advantage as the highest part of the body of seeing the farthest, and thus from its high place being able to intelligently instruct and direct the action of those members which live on a lower plane, and are depending-upon the head for direction

If the body is to function normally, the authority of the head must be constantly recognized. This is true of every member of the body, and especially true of those who are ministers in the body. Such ministers may be likened to those parts of the body, such as the hands and feet which are most active, and play such a prominent part in the functioning of the body in its varied activities. Such members are tempted to 'think that they are indispensable, and thus can set up a new center of authority. This, of course, produces confusion.

True ministry gifts, being those men ordained by God to minister to His people, are the gifts of the risen Head to the body, for it is written, "When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men... He gave some apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers," (Eph. 4:8, 11). Such men are God-gifted and appointed. They are not placed in the body to further some certain division or sect, and use their God-given abilities to enlarge a segment of the whole, but they are placed in the body "for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ," (Eph. 4:12). Their interest is body-wide, they are affectionately disposed toward all God's people, and are obliged by reason of the nature of their calling to seek to build up the whole body of Christ.

No, Christ is not divided! His body is one. There is but one head of the body, and that is the risen Christ. Thus, every attempt to promote a group of God's people as a segregated section as opposed to all the rest of the people of God is to work at cross purposes with the divine programme

"Was Paul crucified for you?" is the second question. Who deserves our first loyalty? All our fellow humans, much as we esteem and love them, must never come between our undivided loyalty to Christ and His word. Many of those who would divide and rend the body of Christ are certainly not prepared to die for anybody, and before we take a hand in promoting some injurious division, let us remember that those whom we are influencing are the purchase of Jesus' blood.

The final question of the trio is, "Were ye baptized in the name of Paul?" If these party leaders were so important as to create a division among God's people, then why did they take in public confession at their baptism a place of identification with the Lord Jesus? The argument is overwhelming. There is no place for the exaltation of human leaders, and much harm is done all around when such exaltation is promoted.

The divine ideal is beautiful, and we dare not despise it by saying, "It will not work." Let us listen to it humbly as God's pronounced desire for His people—"Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment." (I Cor. 1:10)

That this condition of division is serious is clearly stated by the apostle as he continues his instruction, writing, "I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ... For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men? For while one saith, I am of Paul, and another, I am of Apollos; are ye not carnal?' (I Cor. 3:1, 3, 4.) It is evident therefore, that party-spirited people are incapable of receiving mature instruction, and will always be found singing the praises of human leadership, making pretty comments on pulpit mannerisms, and the personal appearance and personality niceties of preachers. They have little or no time for an in-dustrious study of God's Word, or a diligent seeking after the Lord. They are God's undeveloped children, for while they are not babes in the matter of years of professed salvation, they are "as babes" in the matter of understanding and conduct. They have not developed normally with the years, and are a heartache to the Father. We can imagine the constant pain in a mother's heart as she watches her growing child, noticing physical development, and yet aware that the mind is not developing with the body. How our Heavenly Father, too, must look with sorrow upon us as we go from year to year devolping in re-ligious activity and church attendance, and yet undeveloped in our knowledge of His will through the Word.

Paul, having dealt with the sin of schism and having scored it as being wrong, now proceeds to deal with the true evaluation of the minister and his ministry. "Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos," he says, "but ministers by whom ye believed, even as the Lord gave to every man?" These men who lead you to Christ and serve you in the ministry of the Word are "but ministers" which means "servants," and if they are able to help you, it is because "the Lord gave to every man (each one)." Each one of these ministers received their ability and particular ministry

from God, and so Paul goes on to say, "I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase." As in gardening, one plants the seed, another waters it, and the unseen forces of growth give the increase; so in the field of Christian service, one minister plants, another waters, and God, like the unseen forces of growth, gives the increase.
"So then neither is he that planteth any thing.

neither is he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase." Compared to God, ministers are nothing. When the true power in Christian service is readily understood, then the ministry fades look at the things seen. God is everything. He is the One who imparts eternal life to believing sinners. He alone is to be recognized and worshipped as leader.

Furthermore, rather than ministers being competitors and leaders of individual groups, the apostle says, "He that planteth and he that watereth are one." They are not rival leaders, each boasting of his particular sect. True ministry usually becomes divided when God ceases to be the supreme motive for service. When a denomination or a creed takes the place of God, then the ministry ceases to be experimentally one. It is decidedly wrong therefore, to speak of ministers as rivals, and is a sign of carnality.

"Every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labor." One minister is not better than another, and each shall be rewarded according to his labor. The humblest ministry will be as abundantly rewarded as the more popular type. Let this serve as a warning to all who seek for fame and applause. God will reward ministers according to their labor, not according to what is generally considered success.

"It is required in stewards that a man be found faithful." The minister need not fret and worry about his popularity with the crowd as com-pared to the popularity of his fellow-ministers. If he is faithful to Christ and His Word, he can enjoy the incomparable inner rest that comes from knowing that he is being a true servant, faithful to his Master, and faithful to his task

Rather than treating the people's opinion of himself as something important, Paul says "that to me it is a very small thing that I should be judged by you." He was doing the best he knew, and as he observed his labors, was able to say, and as he observed his labors, was able to say, "I know nothing against myself... However, I am not hereby justified." The people's opinion of him, and his opinion of himself was not the final opinion. The final word was the Lord's. "For," says Paul, "he that judgeth me is the Lord," and the day is coming when the Lord will indeed the control of the basis of any indeed judge our service, not on the basis of apparent success, but on the basis of our motives, for in that day He "will make manifest the counsels of the hearts." This is a very solemnizing fact, and ought to bring preacher and people alike to their knees in humble heart-searching to ascertain our motives and make sure that we are working on sound priciples.

No minister has a right to boast, "For who maketh thee to differ from another? And what hast thou that thou didst not receive? Now if thou didst receive it, why dost thou glory as if thou hadst not received it?" Let us not indulge in carnal comparisons, but receive with thanksgivi ing every gift of God, thanking Him for His appointed evangelists, and pastors and teachers, and as they seek to feed us the Word of God, and thrill our hearts with their exhortation and comfort, let all the glory be His, Who is the head of the body, and the Lord of His church, and the King of His Kingdom.

WHEN WILL HE COME?



The most important event of history was the death of the Saviour at Calvary, by which men through His Blood are redeemed from sin. But that was a day of infamy and shame, when man committed murder against his Maker. The most wonderful event of history is the translation of the righteous, at which moment mortal man shall suddenly be changed into the likeness of the glorified Saviour, and be united forever with Him. Two places in the Scriptures speak particularly of this event.

"For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words." I Thes. 4:15-18.

"Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump; for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality." I Cor. 15:51-53.

What thrilling words are these, that suddenly, in a moment of time, in a twinkling of an eye, we shall be changed, raptured, caught up to meet the Lord in the air, having instantly received a new body, one never subject to death, glorified and changed into the likeness of His glorious body. Such a hope should stir us to our depths, especially since all signs point to the fact that this event will transpire in our own lifetime. That suddenly while we are in the midst of the duties of the day, we hear a reverberating sound! We wonder! Every part of our being is alerted—can it be? Surely not, yes, this is it! As in a dream we are whisked away, our body feels strangely light; then wonder of wonders the heavens open before our raptured gaze; we see angels in multitudes descending, and there, in the center of all, outshining all, is the Saviour. Then shall we realize as never before, that it has been worth it all, every sacrifice, every hardship—the very thought of all such things fades away, as we enter the threshold of a glorious eternity with Jesus.

The Translation of Enoch and Elijah

This impending event of which we speak, has precedent in Old Testament history. Enoch, a prophet of anti-Diluvian times, warned the wicked of his day, foretelling the coming of judgment. He walked with God, and "was not, for God took him." Likewise Elijah, in the presence of Elisha, was caught up to heaven by a chariot with horses of fire. These are the only two men in history who have been taken to heaven without dying. They are verily a type of that great company, which at the coming of the Lord shall be caught up to meet the Lord without tasting of death. As Elijah was taken up in a moment of time, so this company shall be translated in a moment, in a twinkling of an eye. Christ's coming is specifically stated as occurring suddenly, as the swift movement of a flash of lightning. (Matt. 24:27). This refutes the theory that the Lord's coming is gradual, or that men shall in the course of time recognize His Presence in the world.

The Opening of the Graves

Attendant with the rapture of the living shall be the resurrection of the righteous dead. When Christ arose from the dead, an angel came and rolled the stone away, bringing great fear upon the soldiers who stood guard. Also many of the saints of Old Testament days were raised at the same time that Christ was resurrected. In their case the graves were violently thrown open. (Matt. 27:51:53). It would appear likely then, that when the resurrection of the New Testament saints takes place, their graves too will be thrown open-an event, no doubt, that will cause the mortals who remain to be filled with great fear and foreboding.

The Glorified Body

In our day scientists have learned many astonishing secrets of nature. They have probed the atom, and the deeper their investigation, the more amazing are their discoveries. Atoms are composed of electrons revolving at the incomprehensible speed of a quadrillion times a second about a heavier center, not unlike the revolving of the planets around the sun. But wonderful as the atom is, it is physical, and its materiality is infinitely grosser than heavenly materiality, which has no difficulty in passing through solid objects. Thus it was that Jesus when He visited the disciples, when Thomas was with them, passed through the walls, the doors being shut. (John 20:26). It should be noted that this glorified body is not to be confused with

QUESTIONS and ANSWERS

QUESTION: IF SICKNESS IS CAUSED BY DEMONS, WHAT IS THE RELATION TO MEDICINE? IF CERTAIN MEDICINES EXPEDITE THE BODY'S CURING ITSELF OF DISEASE, THEN THE DEMON-CAUSED DISEASE IS HELPED BY THE MEDICINE, AND THE MEDICINE DEPRIVES THE DEMON OF ITS HABITATION. IF THAT ALL IS TRUE, THEN THE DEMONS WOULD OPPOSE SCIENTISTS AND DOCTORS WHO DEVELOP ANTI-BODIES AND MEDICINES. F.G.

HIS is a rather complex question. To understand it fully, would require some knowledge of the action of medicine, as well as the nature of disease, and the peculiarities of the activities of demons. In the space available, we may only briefly discuss this subject.

THE PLACE OF PHYSICIANS

We do not believe that it is helpful to condemn or despise the medical profession. The Bible commends the sympathetic care of the sick and the suffering. (Luke 5:31 and 10:30-37). It would appear that nature itself teaches that there should be those trained in the care and knowledge of the body. When a child is born in a home, should an untrained person attend the birth, or rather one skilled in the science of obstetrics? The main function of a physician, however, should be to prevent disease rather than to cure it, by teaching people the laws of health. After the Lord gave them a series of laws regulating diet, rest, cleanliness, segregation, quarantining of sickness, etc.

There is a second field in which specialists have achieved a certain success through the use of natural means, that is surgery. A dentist (a doctor of the teeth can fill a decayed tooth, though the only way he can help a sick tooth is to pull it. In the same way a surgeon unable to cure a gangrened limb, may amputate it, and replace it with an artificial one. However, if a disease has spread too far, surgery fails, especially in cancer, for with the removal of diseased parts, organs vital to the body are destroyed.

There is a third method that physicians use to prevent disease—inoculation. In this case, they take advantage of the body's mechanism to build up anti-bodies against specific diseases. A person is given a light form of a disease, so that his body will build up an anti-toxin which will resist the more virulent forms of the disease, a person vaccinated is generally made immune from small-pox for a certain specified time.

The fourth method physicians use in combating disease is to use drugs which will kill germs after they have entered the body. There is nothing mysterious about this, as germs are a simple form of life, and all physical life is vulnerable to cer-

tain poisons. Germicides easily kill skin infections, because they can be readily applied to the skin. But inside the body, germs have a peculiar way of lurking in hidden recesses where the potency of the drug cannot reach them. Quinine powerfully antiseptic to malaria, may temporarily cure the patient, but it usually is not able to destroy all the germs. Hence malaria once contracted is often recurrent. This circumstance is one of the great weaknesses of medicine to cure disease.

Penicitlin, one of the so-called "wonder drugs," recently discovered, has proved to be, perhaps, the most powerful of all drugs in combatting direase. But even it has been found to have serious limitations. Not a few people are allergic to penicillin and may be seriously poisoned by it. Moreover, successive injections of the drug tend to produce a penicillin-resistant strain of bacteria, against which the drug has little power.

Thus far we have considered sickness apart from demon oppression and possession. Medicine has some effect against disease germs, but is utterly impotent against demons. Disease germs and demons are not the same thing, one is physical, the other is spirit—though they have a common master. Satan has in some way perverted certain kinds of bacteria, so that they are harmful to man. (There are hundreds of varieties of beneficial germs and bacteria.) Job 2:7, reveals that Satan was directly responsible for the boils coming on the patriarch Job. Now boils are not demons, but are caused by disease germs. Yet Satan put the boils on Job! Sickness then is indirectly caused by Satan through disease germs. It is of the works of Satan, but not necessarily demon possession. It can, however, lead, and in many cases does—as Satan no doubte has planned—to actual demon oppression or possession of part or all of the body, if the disease is not arrested.

How does demon possession of part or all of the body take place? There are several ways in which this can happen, but in each case there is involved a weakening of the nervous system. In other words, evil spirits cannot attack and enter the human body at will. A severe sickness, however, may so weaken some part of the nervous system that an evil spirit may fasten itself upon part or all of the body. Demons may likewise secure control as the result of an accident, or through an inherited weakness. Demons may also take control of the mind, of an individual who gives himself over to excessive fear, worry, or moral depravity, or to playing with evil spirits as spiritualists do. (For further information on this subject, read pages 90-93 of our book BIBLE DAYS ARE HERE AGAIN.)

THE CASTING OUT OF DEMONS

Now let us consider the problem of ejecting demons. As has been said before, demons cannot enter the human body at will. If that were not true, soon everyone would be demon-possessed. The human body normally repels an exterior spirit. (Some people indeed find it very hard to yield to the Spirit of God). When a person becomes sick, the defensive agencies of the body usually repel the disease germs, and the body recovers. Physicians at this stage sometimes are able to assist nature—but mark this, that is all they can do, assist the natural healing powers of the body. If however, the body weakens sufficiently, a demon is able to get control, by settling on some nervous center of the body. Medicine is completely impotent against demons. It is at this stage that physicians are completely baffled. The person may then be sent from doctor to doctor, but eventually he is declared incurable. The person cannot be cured until the demon oppression is cast away, which is only possible through the power of the name of Jesus. Such was the case of the woman who had the serious back injury, whom Christ healed. (Luke 13:16.)

Consider the case of a cancer, which begins with a bruised cell. No drug applied to the cancer will kill it, for it has a diabolical life from Satan that has caused the cell to become insane as it were, and it goes into a wild multiplication of cells. If the cancer is caught early enough the surgeon may be of help. He simply removes that part of the body that contains cancer, and the life of the cancer dies. But if the cancer is allowed to grow until it enters a wide area of the body, its removal will entail the destruction of vital organs. It is then the same problem as that of ejecting the demons from an insane man with natural means. You can kill the insane man, and the demons no longer have a body, but for obvious reasons this method is not to be desired.

Thus we see the inefficacy of medicine to cast out demons, once they have control over the body. Physicians may be able to prevent disease, or assist nature in curing itself in the early

People in desperation will submit themselves to long and costly processes of medical experimentation, and physicians may do their best, but too often the story is the same as that of the woman with the issue of blood that came to Jesus. The record declares that she "had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse." Mark 5:25-26. But when she, in faith touched the hem of the garment of Christ, she was instantly made whole. Christ is the Great Physician, the Healer of every disease. Without hesitation we may recommend Him to every sick person. Divine Healing is God's provided way of deliverance for those who have faith in God. The Great Physician succeeds where all others fail. Healing from heaven is the believer's way of life, having been purchased at great cost by the Saviour himself. (Matt. 8:14-17.)

Concerning this testimony of healing of my stone blind eye, I wish to say that these statements can be attested by some very prominent physicians and surgeons who examined me, both before and after healing of my eye.

For the record, I will say that my father was a Methodist minister and I had seen wonderful healings over a period of years, yet like some disciples and prophets of old, I discounted and limited the power of God. It took me forty-five years, and only after much worry and distress from a mental angle, to bring myself to a place where I would acquiesce to the simplicity of the teachings of Jesus Christ, and accept them by faith. There is a throne room in a man's heart and until such a time as he fills that room with the love of God, he feels very much out of order. I left the hospital the next morning before the operation, went home and enjoyed a delightful night's rest, and woke up the next morning perfectly healed. Some of the examining doctors were startled and amazed when they examined me after my healing. Dr. C. F. Lehenkering, physician and surgeon, of Darlington, W. Va., examined me before and after my ill-

In conclusion, I trust for any who might read this testimony, that it will tend to strengthen their faith, that they too, may be healed of their diseases, and infirmities through having implicit faith and confidence in God.






